VOICE and KEYBOARD

This collection contains songs which were composed for voice and figured bass (basso continuo). The editors are convinced that an adequate rendering of the figured bass by arranger and performer is essential for a real understanding of nearly 200 years of music (c. 1700-1800). In our opinion it is the underestimation of this problem which has led to the true appreciation of numerous treasures of this period. "A good 'harpsichord rendering'" of the figured bass means: composition, arrangement in the style of the respective composer and, above all, a knowledge of the required instrument, and playing in proportion to the other vocal parts.

The accompaniments in this collection have been written especially for the harpsichord, but they will suit the piano as well. The editor suggests that you adjust the piano-tone to the required style. Also arrangements for organ can be made by adding them with the necessary slight alterations.

The editors are aware that this collection is only one of several possible solutions. Therefore we offer to everybody a chance of reconsidering this question. In the transcription of the figured bass, the original key is given, and the suggested transpositions in brackets.
