## Anmerkung

Phrasierungsbögen ergeben sich aus dem musikalischen Zusammenhang und lassen dem Spieler die Freiheit der Einteilung und Gestaltung der phrasentechnischen Gesichtspunkten. Das Bartók-Pizzicato ist mit  $\delta$  bezeichnet. In  $\delta$ -bezeichneten Teilen ist die zeitliche Notation nicht maßgebend. Sie gibt ein graphisches Bild des ungefähren Zeitablaufs. In den mit **Frei** bezeichneten Teilen kommt es auf die Gesamtwirkung an, die den Eindruck eines bewegten Geschehens erwecken kann, nicht auf die Einzelnote. Das Zusammenspiel soll fließend sein und einen Eindruck rhythmischer Motorik erwecken bzw. die zugrunde liegende Taktrudimente verdeutlichen.

## Annotation

Phrases are determined by the musical context, allowing the player to decide on their length and shape according to the phrasing techniques used. Bartók pizzicato is indicated with  $\delta$ . In sections marked  $\delta$ , the length of notes marked is not intended to be prescriptive, but to give an impression of their approximate duration. In sections marked **Frei** (freely), the overall effect created by a lively cluster of notes, rather than any individual notes, is the focus. The performance should flow, with no sense of driving rhythms and without drawing attention to the underlying bar structure.
