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## Foreword

**Argorù V/a** is a unique work for solo bass clarinet that blends Simon's superb sequential treatment of material and clarity of form in a contemporary jazz setting. From the "Blues-like" introduction to the concluding section, phrasing and detailed articulation markings reflect the author's deep knowledge of the jazz idiom. His successful incorporation of extended techniques on the bass instrument, such as slap tongue and multiphonics, make this piece an attractive addition to the solo bass clarinet repertoire.
