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Diese Reihe kleiner Stücke wurde ausgewählt und für zwei Gitarren überarbeitet, um auch den Gitarristen die Welt Bach's zugänglich zu machen. Obgleich die Kompositionen in einer Linie für das Clavichord gedacht waren, kommen die spezifischen Möglichkeiten der Gitarre dieser Klangvorstellung entgegen. Zugleich wird mit der vorliegenden Ausgabe dem Gitarrspieler wertvolles Material gegeben, das den vom einstimmigen Clavichord und den Unfehlbarkeitswerken eine willkommene Ergänzung sein wird. Bis auf notwendige Oktav-Versetzungen, gelegentlichen Transpositionen und die Ausschreiben der Verzierungen wurden keine Änderungen vorgenommen. Die Herausgabe stellt Vorschläge des Herausgebers dar.

Afin de rendre accessibles aux guitaristes la musique de Bach, nous avons fait choix d'une série de petites pièces que nous avons réalisées pour deux guitares. À l'origine, elles furent sans doute pour la plupart destinées au clavichord, mais la sonorité si particulière étroitement à notre instrument. En même temps ce travail offre au guitariste un matériel précieux, propre à compléter opportunément les exercices de la seule voix qui forment l'essentiel des méthodes courantes. Exception faite de quelques transpositions nécessaires, notamment à l'octave, et de la réalisation des ornements, nous n'avons apporté aucun changement au texte original. Quant aux doigts, ils ne constituent pas des suggestions de notre part.

This series of small pieces was chosen and transcribed for two guitars in order to open up world of Bach to the guitarists as well. Though the compositions were intended in the first place for the clavichord, the specific sound of the guitar seems to approach that of the clavichord quite closely. At the same time, the guitarist is presented with some valuable material to complement conveniently the educational works based on homophony.

Changes to the music have been some necessary octave transpositions, transpositions in convenient keys, and the writing out of the ornaments. Fingering has also been added, as suggestions by the editor.
