Preface

'Guitar Fun' is the name we gave to this production. It is a collection of short and easy pieces for teaching purposes or simply just for fun. What is a kind of music is fun? – a question one will have to ask for oneself. Most people would agree however, that a piece of music should have an attractive melody, interesting accompanying chords and a steady flow of rhythm to keep it moving along – components found in compositions from Bach to the Beatles.

Whether or not I have succeeded in achieving these aims is again a matter of taste, but my aim was to be heard and hit as hard on the head as possible. If you enjoy the book, why not try the other two in the series? There are solos, duets and trios.

A few words for the teacher. Throughout the series, most of the quavers (or eighth-notes) are to be played straight, as indicated by ♩ . In the few swing-type pieces, the quavers can be played in triplet fashion, indicated by $\text{♩} = \text{♩} = \text{♩}$. Chords are depicted with Δ .
